

Audi Denver LITTLETON TWILIGHT CRITERIUM

The Audi Denver Littleton Twilight Criterium has grown into one of America's most raced, watched and loved bike races. In 2024 it will once again be live streamed and part of the [American Criterium Cup](#) featuring the nation's best professional bike racers. Bring the whole family and experience live music featuring [Those Crazy Nights](#), on site food and beer service, a 15-minute on-course Cruiser Ride for the entire family, a kids zone, and an exhibitor area right off the start/finish line. **Winner of Best Event, Governor's Award for Downtown Excellence.** See [LittletonCrit.com](#).

COURSE: Fast, flat .8 mile "L" circuit through Historic Downtown Littleton.

RACE: Categories are scored individually and can be identified by bib numbering sequence and bib color. Neutral support is wheels in and wheels out. Volunteers race free, but must [sign up](#) BEFORE registering.

LOCATION: Downtown Littleton, Main & Prince Street. Race held rain or shine. Parking at Arapahoe Community College and surrounding streets.

ONLINE REGISTRATION: Register online at [bikereg.com/littleton](#). Online registration closes Wednesday, July 31 at 11:59 p.m. Cancel anytime before closing for a full refund.

ON-SITE/IN-PERSON REGISTRATION: Register at the Welcome Party on August 2 from 6-8 p.m. at Audi Denver, or on race day starting at 1 p.m. and closing 60 minutes prior to race start. On-site/in-person registration is \$10 more than online.

RACE NUMBER PICKUP AND STAGING: Number pickup will be available at the Welcome Party on August 2 from 6-8 p.m. at Audi Denver, or on race day starting at 1 p.m. and closing 60 minutes prior to race start. Race staging and course entry will be on Nevada Street on either side of the course. **NO ENTRY IS ALLOWED AT START/FINISH.**

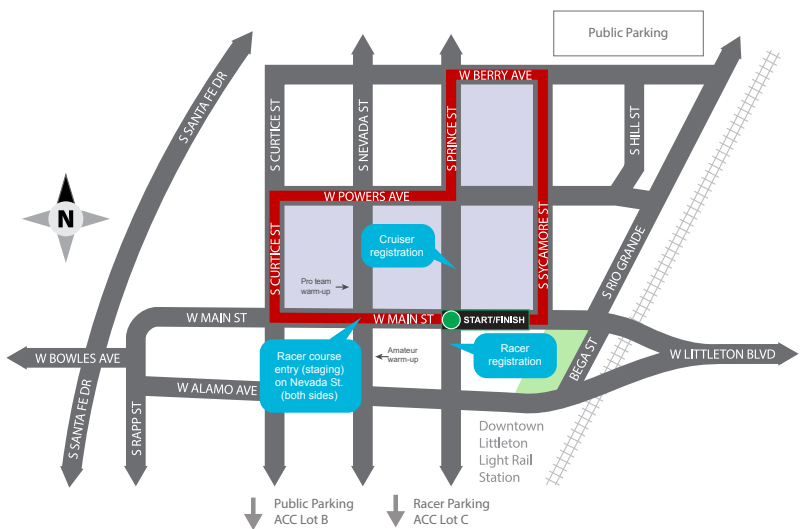

- USAC release waiver must be signed by all racers or by a parent/legal guardian for racers 18 years or younger, including participants in the Cruiser Ride.
- USAC license required. Annual licenses are available online at [usacycling.org](#). USAC 1-day licenses are also available through online or on-site registration. No license is needed for the Cruiser Ride.

REDSTONE BANK CRUISER RIDE: The Cruiser Ride is free but registration is required. Register online at [LittletonCrit.com](#), or in-person starting at 1 p.m. on race day on Prince Street just north of the start/finish line. Helmets are required and costumes are encouraged. USAC permit pending.
