Day of registration will take place at the registration tent near the start (excludes collegiate events). We will open at 7:30 am and close 20 minutes before the start of each category, Entry fee includes USAC Surcharges. **RACE DAY**

REGISTRATIONS MUST BE PAID IN CASH OR CHECK, NO CARD!

Rules

All USAC Rules apply including junior gear and bike restrictions.

Circuit Race: Centerline Rule, Feed Zone (available for races longer than 45 mi) and discard zones in effect. **No support on the road – Bring spare & pump.** However, there will be a wheel pit at the finish line – Wheels in, wheels out.

There will be NO PARKING AT THE START FINISH/ALONG THE FEED ZONE. Park along Country Road 56 (the dirt) past where the race enters the hills community if you are feeding. You will have to ride back to the start.

Please PICK UP YOUR TRASH/PUT WRAPPERS IN YOUR POCKET. The Hills community is very receptive of our race, but they ask we leave no trash and do not damage their grass.

Criterion: Free lap rule in effect until 5 laps to go in each field. Wheel pit at start - Wheels in, wheels out.

License and Membership

USAC races: USAC Race or Collegiate license required. USAC 1-day license is \$15, only for Cat 5 men and women.

Collegiate riders wishing to be scored as collegiate must have a valid Collegiate License

Event Parking and Registration for Cobb Lake will be at the Budweiser Headquarters just south of the Richards Lake Rd and Busch Drive intersection in the Budweiser Experience parking lot. Neutral Zone

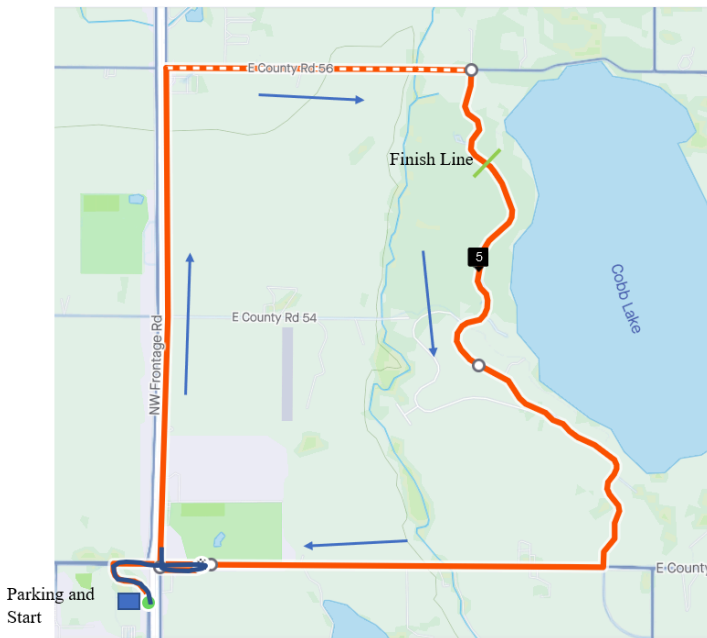
There will be a neutral start (highlighted in blue) from the green dot (start line) until you turn right a second time, heading north on the frontage road. Racing begins on the frontage road.

Lap Count

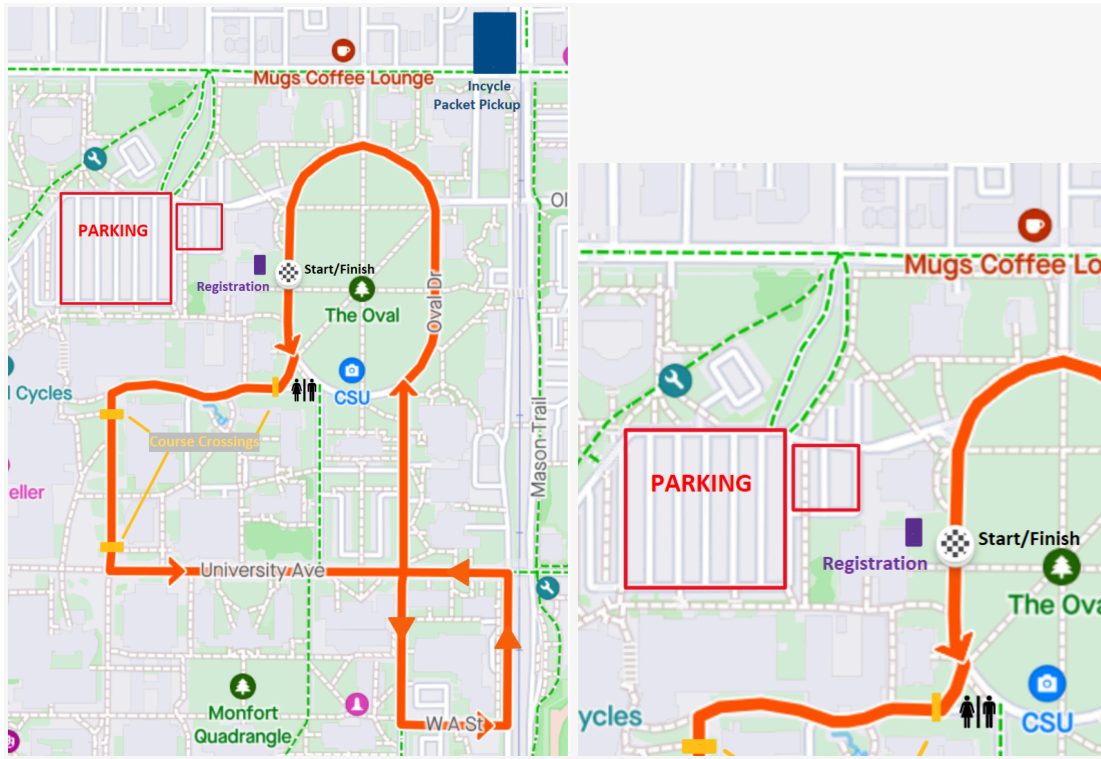
Since the start is on the opposite end of the course from the finish (Red Line), when you cross the finish line for the

first time, your lap count will begin (Example: if your field races 5 laps, it will actually be 5.5 laps total).

Welcome to the new Oval Course! The past route has been changed to avoid Amy Van Dyken Way which has been covered with new road traffic poles/signs that jeopardizes safety of our riders. As this course will be safer, it will not completely prevent crashes. Always remember that the real safety factor is you, the rider.

To get to parking, Exit I-25 at the Mulberry Exit. Head west until you reach College Ave and turn south (left turn). Take College Ave to Laurel St and turn west (right turn).
