2025 Table Mountain Race Series

Wednesday Evening Race Series: June 4, 11, 18, 25; July 2, 9, 16, 23, 30; August 13 Category Pro-1-2-3's begin at 6:00 pm ~ 15 laps Category 4-5's begin at 7:10 pm ~ 12 laps

Location: Colorado State Patrol Academy Track, Golden, Colorado 80401. From South Golden Road turn north on Quaker Street and drive through open green gates where pavement ends and dirt begins. Follow this dirt road up hill to top of Table Mountain where pavement resumes. Parking is allowed on this road and up to 100 feet before the racetrack.

Track Access not available until after ALL law enforcement personnel have left the facilities and the gates/Track have been opened by race personnel.

ONLINE REGISTRATION STRONGLY ENCOURAGED <u>SPECIAL</u>: Sign-up for the entire race series by June 4th for \$350. Non-refundable, non-transferrable. Entry Fee per race: \$40 for adults; \$20 for Juniors Online registration closes at 3:00PM on day of each race. Check-in closes 10 minutes prior to the start of each race.

Eligibility: USAC License Required. USAC 1-Day **Beginner** license: \$15, only for Cat 5 men, Cat 5 Women and Juniors who have never previously held a USAC license with a higher category. Pre-registration will require a One-Day license available online and onsite for race day registration. More information at http://usacycling.org

Registration: Pre-register online at **bikereg.com.** No refunds allowed. If there is a weather-related race cancellation, we will offer a transfer of race fee to a later date. Credit does not expire and can be used the following race season. All registration, USAC paperwork must be properly filled out & signed including the CSP release form available at the race site. If you experience any difficulties during the registration process or have questions, please call Anna-Lisa at 303-562-4924.

Rules: Each race is a combined race for best sprinter and for best finisher. Series points will be awarded for top 5 places on designated laps and for top 10 places at the finish. P,1,2,3's race 15 laps; Cat 4/5's race 12 laps.

Bike Restrictions: Apply to men/women, 14 and under. See USAC Rule 1I5. FREE LAP RULE WILL BE IN EFFECT.

Awards: Prizes for best OVERALL finisher (total accumulated points from sprints and finishes).
